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finding order in diversity religious toleration in the habsburg empire 1792 1848 covers the tumultuous period in the habsburg empire from joseph ii s failed reforms through the revolutions of 1848 documenting the ongoing struggle between religious activism and civil peace in the name of stability the habsburg empire sidelined catholic activists and promoted religious toleration during this era in which austria was an international symbol of conservatism and other states engaged in strident confessional politics austria s well known fear of disorder and revolution in this notoriously conservative regime extended to catholics and the state utilized the censors and police to institutionalize religious toleration which it viewed as essential to law and order and to tame religious passions which officials feared could mobilize public

opinion in unpredictable directions the state's growing use of police power had wide reaching consequences for refugees women and empire building by the end of the nineteenth century the habsburg empire would become known as a multinational and multicultural state but this toleration was the product of the infamously conservative and rigid regime that ruled austria in the decades after the french revolution and until the revolutions of 1848 while the habsburgs typically are associated with catholicism 1780 to 1848 marked the only era in which the habsburgs tried to disassociate themselves politically from catholicism though civil peace and religious toleration eventually became the norm this book documents the decades of heavy handed state efforts to get there

international relations scholars typically expect political communities to resemble one another the more they are exposed to pressures of war economic competition and the spread of hegemonic legitimacy standards however historically it is heterogeneity not homogeneity that has most often defined international systems examining the indian ocean region the centre of early modern globalization andrew phillips and j c sharman explain how diverse international systems can emerge and endure divergent preferences for terrestrial versus maritime conquest congruent traditions of heteronomy and shared strategies of localization were factors which enabled diverse actors including the portuguese estado da india dutch and english company sovereigns and mighty asian empires to co exist for centuries without converging on a common institutional form debunking the presumed relationship between interaction and homogenization this book radically revises conventional thinking on the evolution of international systems while deepening our understanding of a historically crucial but critically understudied world region

this volume brings together interdisciplinary topics in condensed matter theory and related disciplines with an emphasis on the common concerns of mostly theorists applying advanced many particle methods in diverse areas solid state and low temperature physics atomic sub atomic and statistical physics engineering sciences keeping a sharp focus on theoretical developments which cross borders between subfields of condensed matter physics and which provide new approaches to outstanding problems the book records the fascinating variety of new results associated with the idea of similarity in diversity in perusing this volume the reader will be stimulated to discern threads of similarity in the great diversity of physical phenomena and theoretical models proposed to explain them and indeed there are threads that can be glimpsed in the table of contents and ramifications of these threads as one reads through the articles one conclusion is clear the search for similarity in diversity is a powerful approach to interdisciplinary science

paradigm implying a progressive problem shift in the dominant diversity research agenda from a market driven business oriented diversity management to one highly valuing affirming and respecting otherness
